



DUA FOR SAFETY FROM ALL BEASTS, EVILS OF SATAN, THIEVES & DEMONS

Seventeenth: Al-Kulayni and al-Barqi have reported through valid chains of authority that Imam al-Sadiq and Imam al-Kazim (a.s.) said: When evening falls and you look at the sun setting and falling, you may say the following words, because they secure you from all beasts, from the evils of Satan the accursed and his offspring, from whatever bites and stings, and from thieves and demons:

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الرَّحْمَنِ الرَّحِيمِ الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ الَّذِي لَمْ يَتَنَعَّذْ
 وَلَدًا وَ لَمْ يَكُنْ لَّهُ شَرِيكٌ فِي الْمُلْكِ وَالْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ الَّذِي
 يَصْفُ وَلَا يُوْصَفُ وَ يَعْلَمُ وَلَا يُعْلَمُ يَعْلَمُ خَائِنَةَ الْأَعْيُنِ
 وَ مَا تُخْفِي الصُّدُورُ وَ أَعُوذُ بِوْجَهِ اللَّهِ الْكَرِيمِ وَ بِإِسْمِ
 اللَّهِ الْعَظِيمِ مِنْ شَرِّ مَا ذَرَأَ وَ بَرَأَ وَ مِنْ شَرِّ مَا تَحْتَ
 الشَّرْرِ وَ مِنْ شَرِّ مَا ظَهَرَ وَ مَا بَطَنَ وَ مِنْ شَرِّ مَا كَانَ فِي
 الْلَّيْلِ وَ النَّهَارِ وَ مِنْ شَرِّ أَبِي قِنْتَرَةِ وَ مَا وَلَدَ وَ مِنْ شَرِّ
 الرَّئِسِينَ وَ مِنْ شَرِّ مَا وَصَفْتُ وَ مَا لَمْ أَصِفْ وَ الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ
 رَبِّ الْعَالَمِينَ.

Eighteenth: Al-Kulayni has reported through a valid chain of authority that Imam al-Baqir (a.s.) said: Whoever prays



Almighty Allah with this supplicatory prayer in the morning will not be afflicted by any harm on that day, and whoever says it in the evening will not be afflicted by any harm at that night, Allah willing:

**اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَصْبَحْتُ فِي ذَمِّتِكَ وَ جَوَارِكَ اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي
 أَسْتَوْدِعُكَ دِينِي وَ نَفْسِي وَ دُنْيَايَ وَ أَخِرَتِي وَ أَهْلِي وَ مَالِي وَ
 أَعُوذُ بِكَ يَا عَظِيمُ مِنْ شَرِّ خَلْقِكَ جَمِيعًا وَ أَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنْ
 شَرِّ مَا يُبَلِّسُ بِهِ ابْلِيسُ وَ جُنُودُهُ.**

Nineteenth: Al-Kulayni has reported through a semi-authentic chain of authority that a man came to Imam al-Sadiq(a.s.) and asked him to teach him a supplicatory prayer he would say every morning and evening. The Imam (a.s.) therefore instructed him to say the following:

**الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ الَّذِي يَفْعُلُ مَا يَشَاءُ وَ لَا يَفْعَلُ مَا يَشَاءُ غَيْرُهُ
 الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ كَمَا يُحِبُّ اللَّهُ أَنْ يُحْمَدَ الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ كَمَا هُوَ أَهْلُهُ
 الَّهُمَّ أَدْخِلْنِي فِي كُلِّ خَيْرٍ أَذْخَلْتَ فِيهِ مُحَمَّدًا وَ آلَ مُحَمَّدٍ
 وَ أَخْرِجْنِي مِنْ كُلِّ سُوءٍ أَخْرَجْتَ مِنْهُ مُحَمَّدًا وَ آلَ مُحَمَّدٍ
 صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَى مُحَمَّدٍ وَ آلِ مُحَمَّدٍ - .**

Twentieth: In the book of al-Balad al-Amin, the Holy Prophet (s.a.w.a.) is reported to have said: Whoever repeats this saying (composed of Quranic verses) seven



times in the morning, Almighty Allah will save him that whole day:

**فَاللَّهُ خَيْرٌ حَافِظًا وَ هُوَ أَرْحَمُ الرَّاحِمِينَ إِنَّ وَلِيَّ اللَّهِ
الَّذِي نَزَّلَ الْكِتَابَ وَ هُوَ يَتَوَلَّ الصَّالِحِينَ فَإِنْ تَوَلَّوا
فَقُلْ حَسْبِيَ اللَّهُ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا هُوَ عَلَيْهِ تَوَكَّلْتُ وَ هُوَ رَبُّ
الْعَرْشِ الْعَظِيمِ**
